TRANSVAAL TEAMS



MICHAEL KUJAWSKI — an industrialist, is an imaginative player with a flair for the game. In 1960 he won the S.A. Open Team-of-Four Championship and was runner-up in the Transvaal Open Team-of-Four Championship. This year he was runner-up in the S.A. Open Team-of-Four Championship.

EDDIE BERNSTEIN — a clothing manufacturer, has only recently taken to competitive bridge and, as a player of no mean ability, should go far in this field.



RITA JACOBSON — was runner-up in the S.A. Open Pairs in 1957 and winner of that event in 1959. She was winner of the Transvaal Open Pairs in 1955, and the Transvaal Open Team-of-Four in 1957 and 1961. With Bertha Cohen she represented South Africa in Cannes, 1962.

BERTHA COHEN — well known as one of South Africa's leading woman players, won the Transvaal Open Pairs in 1959 and represented South Africa in 1960 in the Women's Series at the World Olympiad in Turin and in the Women's Pairs in Cannes earlier this year.



LEON SAPIRE — a lawyer, is well known in local bridge circles for the part he played in the early days of duplicate in Johannesburg and for his long term of office as editor of the Bridge Bulletin. With his brother he won the S.A. Open Pairs in 1955 and in 1960 he captained the South African teams in Turin.

SYLVAIN DE MIRANDA — a doctor by profession, has for many years been a member of a team that has had an extremely successful career, including winning the 1960 Transvaal Team-of-Four and the 1961 S.A. Open Team-of-Four Championships.



DUGGIE ETTLINGER — a barrister, was runner-up in the S.A. Open Team-of-Four in 1959 and won the Transvaal Team-of-Four that same year. He has compered and adjudicated on the "Bridge on the Air" programme since its inception.

DENNIS HORWITZ — a lawyer, was runner-up in both the S.A. Open Team-of-Four and the S.A. Open Pairs in 1959, won the Transvaal Team-of-Four that same year and this year was runner-up in that event.



DAVID KLUGMAN — a doctor, has in a short bridge career made his mark in local bridge circles and is the current holder of the Transvaal Open Team-of-Four Championship.

BRIAN MARCUS — wholesale merchant, is one of the younger set who has already established himself as a player with a future, and his name is engraved on many of the local floating trophies.



ARNOLD URISOHN — captain of the Cavendish Club teams, is a player of no mean ability, his major successes being winner in the Netaf 1960 Congress Team-of-Four and runner-up in the same event two years later.


